

2020 Summer Reopening Policies and Procedures

Schedule Changes

• HDS will not offer Early Care (7-8am) or After Care (5-6pm). This is because these options require large, mixed groups.

Drop-off and Pick-up Procedures

- Only children and staff members are allowed in the building this time, per CDC recommendations
- Parents will drop-off students at the circle drive in front of the church from 8:00-9:30 and pickup from 2-5.
- Staff members will greet families, take child's temperature (must be under 100.4) and accept only the lunchbox from home
- Children will be asked to bring all items on the first day returning to school and HDS will sanitize those items and keep at school for the summer (blankets, lovies, cups, pacifiers, bottles, etc.).
- Children can not bring any items to school after the first day, except for the lunchbox.
- Floaters will wash hands and sign child in before taking next student

Classroom Families

- Just as families were asked to stay together, apart from other families, our classroom families will stay together and apart from other classroom families in the school
- Classes will not combine and will stay in their assigned space except for recess
- Students will be socially distanced as much as possible during carpet times, table times, meals, and rest time.

Recess

- Classes will recess only with their classroom family
- Recess schedules will be adjusted
- Classes will bring toys to recess that are only used by their classroom family
- Playground will be sanitized by floater between classes

Cleaning

- HDS will assign floaters to wipe down common surfaces such as countertops, kitchen area, door knobs and light switches continually
- Teachers will maintain a "yuck bucket" and place in it all items children put in their mouths. These items will be sanitized.
- Classrooms will be sanitized on a regular schedule.

Health and Safety

- We will take the temperature of employees upon arrival. Anyone with a fever of 100.4 or higher will be sent home to recover.
- We require all students and staff who are not well to stay home. Anyone with a lingering cough or fever should stay home to get well.
- Staff will wear masks.
- Children in 3 year old or older classes should provide a mask from home to wear when in common areas outside of their classroom.

Isolation Policy

• If a child develops a fever at school, the child will be isolated in an unused classroom with a staff member from their class until the parent arrives. Parents are expected to pick up their child within an hour of notification of the fever.

Exposure to Covid-19

- If someone in your household is diagnosed with Covid-19, the child should stay home for at least 14 days, or longer if recommended by the CDC.
- If there is a Covid-19 case at HDS, the staff and students from that class will stay home for 48 hours to allow for the classroom to be cleaned.
