### **Directions:**

- 1) Open <u>ChatGPT</u>. If you have never used ChatGPT before, quickly create an account. If you run into an issue, you can ask me or one of your group members for assistance.
- 2) Copy and paste the prompt below into your ChatGPT conversation.

"You are Ned Smith, the head of school at Episcopal High School. You are writing a short birthday note to Greg Thomas, a former board member who is turning 65 years old. In this birthday note, be sure to congratulate Greg and to express our appreciation for the years he served on the board and the impact he made on our community. Make sure the note is not overly formal, and limit it to 480 characters max."

3) Edit the prompt above to fit scenario 1(below) and see what ChatGPT outputs. Discuss your results with your group.

**Scenario 1:** An alumna of the school, Cathy Dixon, has just published a best selling novel and your head of school wants to send a short note to congratulate her.

4) Once you are happy with ChatGPT's output, copy and paste the text into handwrytten.com


## **Discussion questions:**

## Group 2 - Identify custom FAQ bot opportunities for your school community.

  - Tell me about off campus lunch privileges.
  - How does my daughter move from regular English to honors English?
  - What time does campus close?
- 2) Discuss as a group: Can you imagine a use case for an FAQ bot in your office? What documents would it need in its knowledge base? What are the risks of using a bot?
- 3) Review the information below about automation and to consider what time consuming, repetitive, and mundane tasks you regularly perform that could potentially be automated.



# Group 3 - Learn how AI can synthesize multiple schedules to help you find shared availability.

## **Directions:**

- 1) Open <u>ChatGPT</u>. If you have never used ChatGPT before, quickly create an account. If you run into an issue, you can ask me or one of your group members for assistance.
- 2) Copy and paste this prompt into your ChatGPT conversation:

"You are a master scheduler. Please find a time slot where all three school administrators (Head of School, Associate Head of School, and Athletic Director) can meet together. You will think step by step to be sure you find a time slot that works for all three administrators. I'm going to send you their schedules one at a time. After you receive one, you will wait for the next."

- 3) Once you enter that prompt, ChatGPT will ask you for the reports. You can download the administrator schedule <u>here</u>. Once you have the schedules downloaded, simply copy and paste them one by one into your Chat GPT conversation.
- 4) Review the output you get from ChatGPT and discuss it with the people around you. What other organizational challenges might AI be helpful with?

## Group 4 - Learn how AI can support an email drafting process in an emotionally charged situation.

#### **Directions:**

- 1) Open <u>ChatGPT</u>. If you have never used ChatGPT before, quickly create an account. If you run into an issue, you can ask me or one of your group members for assistance.
- 2) Imagine you have just been sent the following email:

"Dear. Ms. Smith,

I'd like you to schedule a meeting with the head of school for tomorrow after school so that he can explain to me why we're spending \$36,000 dollars a year for a school that refuses to give our son the opportunities he deserves.

Today, Josh came home on the verge of tears after being told that he did not make the varsity lacrosse team. Josh is a rising senior which makes this decision especially vindictive. Coach Michaels clearly has a vendetta against him, because I happen to know that Josh is a more talented athlete than half of last year's varsity team. It is extremely important that Josh be on the varsity team because he is relying on this for his college applications next fall. The entire point of sending him to this school was to get into a good college, and honestly it feels like you all are actively working against us.
